# FY14Q3 – DAW Information Summary – Auditing Highlights



## Defense Acquisition Workforce Size Highlights

- The current Auditing Defense Acquisition Workforce count is 4,318, up from 3,638 in FY08, a total increase of 680
- The Auditing Defense Acquisition Workforce count was at its highest point (4,505) in FY12, and its lowest point (2,852) in FY07
- The Agency with the largest increase, since FY08 is DCAA, with an increase of 723
- The Agencies with the largest decreases, since FY08, are DoD IG, DLA, and DCMA, with decreases of 29 (-100%), 8 (-100%), and 4 (-80%), respectively

## Defense Acquisition Workforce DAWIA Certification Highlights


- The current Auditing Defense Acquisition Workforce DAWIA Meets/Exceeds certification rate is 84.6%; up from 76.1% in FY08
- The current Auditing Meets/Exceeds certification rate is up 11.2% from FY08
- The current Auditing Defense Acquisition Workforce DAWIA 24 month grace period rate is 13.0%; down from 23.3% in FY08
- The current Auditing Defense Acquisition Workforce DAWIA Does Not Meet certification rate is 2.4%; up from 0.7% in FY08

## Defense Acquisition Workforce DAWIA Retirement Eligibility Highlights

- Senior Career Group 39.9% (10 years or less to retirement eligibility or retirement eligible)
- 11.8% are currently eligible to retire, ↓ 13.2% in FY08
- Mid Career Group 20.0% (11 to 20 years to retirement), 20.5% in FY08
- Future Career Group 40.0% (21 to 25+ years to retirement), ↑ from 36.1% in FY08








# FY14Q3 – DAW Information Summary – Overall DAWIA Certification by Career Field

## Certification Level "Meet/Exceed" Rates by Component Audit (FY14Q3)







Gains and Losses by External to DoD, Internal to DoD, and Administrative Categories










# FY13 – DAW Information Summary – Auditing Internal/External Loss % by Career Group



Turnover Percent by Career Lifecycle Groups





## Certification Level "Meet/Exceed" Rates by Component AT&L (FY14Q3)


