Defense Acquisition Workforce Size Highlights

- The current Purchasing Defense Acquisition Workforce count is 1,220, up from 1,196 in FY08, a total increase of 24
- The Purchasing Defense Acquisition Workforce count was at its highest point (2,438) in FY05, and its lowest point (1,170) in FY07
- The Agencies with the largest increases, since FY08, are DLA, and DHA, with increases of 130 (85%), and 18 (900%), respectively
- The Agencies with the largest decreases, since FY08, are AIR FORCE, NAVY, and ARMY, with decreases of 59 (-42%), 45 (-8%), and 33 (-10%), respectively

Defense Acquisition Workforce DAWIA Certification Highlights


- The current Purchasing Defense Acquisition Workforce DAWIA Meets/Exceeds certification rate is 67.5%; up from 52.1% in FY08
- The current Purchasing Meets/Exceeds certification rate is up 29.5% from FY08
- The current Purchasing Defense Acquisition Workforce DAWIA 24 month grace period rate is 22.8%; down from 33.2% in FY08
- The current Purchasing Defense Acquisition Workforce DAWIA Does Not Meet certification rate is 9.8%; down from 14.7% in FY08

Defense Acquisition Workforce DAWIA Retirement Eligibility Highlights

- Senior Career Group 58.0% (742) (10 years or less to retirement eligibility or retirement eligible)
- 22.4% (287) are currently eligible to retire, ↓ from 22.5% in FY08
- Mid Career Group 25.1% (321) (11 to 20 years to retirement), 23.3% in FY08
- Future Career Group 17% (217) (21 to 25+ years to retirement), ↑ from 7.8% in FY08





Certification Level "Meet/Exceed" Rates by Career Field AT&L (FY14Q3)



Certification Level "Meet/Exceed" Rates by Component Purchasing (FY14Q3)








FY13 – DAW Information Summary – Purchasing Workforce Lifecycle Model by YRE




FY13 – DAW Information Summary – Purchasing Gains/Losses – New Hires, Internal/External, Administrative

Gains and Losses by External to DoD, Internal to DoD, and Administrative Categories










FY13 – DAW Information Summary – Purchasing Internal/External Loss % by Career Group



Turnover Percent by Career Lifecycle Groups





Certification Level "Meet/Exceed" Rates by Component AT&L (FY14Q3)


