

2022 DOD ACQUISITION PUBLIC-PRIVATE TALENT EXCHANGE PROGRAM

Call for Partner Organizations

In 2019, the U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) launched its acquisition-focused Public-Private Talent Exchange (PPTe) to enhance opportunities to partner with industry and facilitate increased communication. DoD is inviting components to participate in the 2022 talent exchange, which will provide a platform for mid-career civilians from the private sector and government to gain a better understanding of each other's business operations and share innovative best practices. This professional development program targets high-performers with demonstrated leadership potential. A reciprocal approach will be used; there will be one government participant for each private sector participant. However, this is not a job swap. Each PPTe participant will continue to be compensated by their employer throughout the duration of the exchange.
